Our daily school day will be as follows:

Supervision for students – 7:55am

First Bell for students to enter the building and prepare for their day (lockers, etc) – 8:10am

First class – 8:15am

2:15pm dismissal

Please encourage your child to be on time for all classes. When students are late, they miss important instruction and disrupt the learning of others. Students late for school will be required to make up the time, at a later date, during lunchtime.

Some **important reminders and new procedures** for this coming year:

- -all cell phones, electronics must be left in lockers or turned off/silent during instructional time. If it is seen by a teacher, students will be required to leave it in the office until 2:15pm
- -no backpacks will be allowed in classrooms. Students will be provided school cinch bags or they may carry materials to class
- -students late for school will be required to make up the time during lunchtime, at a later date
- -no food or drinks are allowed during instructional time. Water will be allowed.
- -students must go outside during assigned lunchtime, no exceptions. Please dress appropriately.
