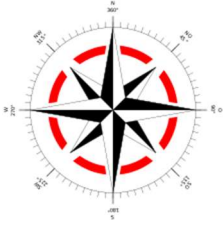

Lunch Time News

- Welcome to our two new lunch monitors! Student lunchtime expectations are as follows:
- If students remain at school for lunch, grade 5 and 6 students must stay inside until 11:45am and then outside from 11:45-12:15pm
 - if students remain at school for lunch, grade 7 and 8 students must go outside until 11:45am and then inside from 11:45-12:15pm
 - there are no more microwaves available for students at school
 - students are reminded to bring their own water bottle, and utensils as the school does not have ones to provide
 - students are expected to remain in a chair during lunchtime and not sit on the tables
 - reminder that garbage is expected to be thrown out by students into the garbage cans
 - students are expected to remain in the lunchroom not wandering the halls



Extra-Curricular News

Any students wishing to attend an extracurricular activity as a spectator must be accompanied by an adult. Coaches are not able to supervise during games, so we ask that students attend to watch with an adult. Well done to our volleyball teams who are having successful seasons! **We also need a Girl's Basketball Coach if any parents/family members are interested!**

Field Trips

We have a lot of activities and field trips happening currently. Please be sure to complete the necessary forms and return it to the school. A reminder that all fees must be paid on school cash. If you are unable to pay for a field trip, please contact the main office for support. No student will miss out on a school opportunity.

Bus

Many of our students travel on the school busses to and from home. This is a wonderful service that we have for students. We ask that you take the time to speak to your child about bus behaviour as it has become a safety concern.

Students must remain seated at all times while on the bus.

Students must keep their hands and head inside the bus at all times.

Students are not permitted to eat or drink while on the bus.

Students are not permitted to bring scooters or other equipment on the bus.

We are also very concerned with students taking Metro Transit at lunchtime and at the end of the day. The school has no authority on what time the busses come or their route. We understand many students like to go to MacDonald's and other establishments at lunchtime, however, this is becoming very dangerous for many students. Students are attempting to run to the bus stop so they can get the first bus out at lunchtime as well as after school. We encourage all students to stay at school for lunch as this is the safest place for them to be. However, if you give permission for your child to leave the premises, please speak to them about being safe and responsible while doing so.

Evening of Music

Our first evening of music will take place on December 6th from 6:30pm-8pm, with a snow day of December 7th. Students in grade 5, 5/6, 6, all band and all violins will be performing on this evening. Please clear your calendar for this wonderful evening of young performers.

The Weather Outside
