We are seeing a huge increase in students asking for food throughout the school day. Please ensure your child brings enough snacks/food to get them through the day. We run a breakfast program

everyday for all students in the school, and cannot sustain purchasing and handing out food all day. As of Monday, except for exceptional circumstances, we will be letting students know food will no longer be handed out throughout the day.

Morning Supervision

Morning supervision begins at 7:55am. Students enter the building at 8:10 am. Just a reminder all grade 5 and 6 students enter the building through the doors closest to the field while grade 7 and 8 students enter through the main doors. Any students arriving after 8:10, please enter through the main doors and be sure to check into the office.

Lunch Time News

Student lunchtime expectations are as follows: If students remain at school for lunch, grade 5 and 6 students must stay inside until 11:45am and then outside from 11:45-12:15pm

- -if students remain at school for lunch, grade 7 and 8 students must go outside until 11:45am and then inside from 11:45-12:15pm
- -there are no more microwaves available for students at school
- -students are reminded to bring their own water bottle, and utensils as the school does not have ones to provide
- -students are expected to remain in a chair during lunchtime and not sit on the tables
- -reminder that garbage is expected to be thrown out by students into the garbage cans
- -students are expected to remain in the lunchroom not wandering the halls
- **If students are arriving late after lunch, we will be asking them to give you a call so you are aware they are missing instructional time.
